3. How do we, like Naaman, try to buy our cleansing? Why can't we do it?
4. Why was Naaman angry at Elisha?
5. Naaman was cleansed in a muddy river; we can be cleansed in a bloody river. Who's blood alone can save us? Why?

## **QUESTIONS FOR PRIVATE REFLECTION**

1. How ought Naaman's leprosy reorient my perspective on the rich and famous in the world?
2. Does the simplicity of the gospel ever irritate me? Do I tend to overcomplicate God's saving grace?
3. How could I use the story of Naaman to share the gospel with someone in the coming week?
