III. Behold Christ's lowly exaltation (vv. 9-11).

QUESTIONS FOR FAMILY WORSHIP

1. When Lloyd-Jones was asked how one could become humble, how did he respond?
2. What does it mean for Christ to empty Himself? Does He become less than God? What did Pastor Nick mean when he said this emptying was by way of addition, not subtraction?
3. Can God be humble? Why, or why not? If not, what word could we use to explain the Son coming down to us to take on human flesh?
4. How did Christ show perfect creaturely humility in His life and death?
5. What was God's reward for Christ's humble, loving obedience? Why should this encourage us to pursue humility in Christ now?

QUESTIONS FOR PRIVATE REFLECTION

1. Since this sermon series began in September 2020 have I grown downward in humility, upward in the fear of God, and outward in love?
2. What are some of the big takeaways that I have gleaned from this sermon series?
3. How can I continue to cultivate the downward disposition of a Godward self-perception? How can I encourage others in the church to grow in the same?
