QUESTIONS FOR FAMILY WORSHIP

1. Why is it significant that the Spirit is poured out on the day of Pentecost? How did Pentecost relate to the Passover and to the giving of the law at Sinai?
2. Who is the one pouring out the Spirit here?
3. Why should we expect to find signs and wonders on Pentecost, but not today?
4. Why is there so much focus upon tongues, languages, and speaking at Pentecost? What is Christ giving His Spirit for?
5. What happened at Babel (Gen. 11:1ff.) and how is Christ reversing it at Pentecost?
6. What are some lessons we learn from Pentecost about the church today?

QUESTIONS FOR PRIVATE REFLECTION

1. How would I respond to a Christian who told me they were waiting to share the gospel with their neighbor until they are clothed with power from on high?
2. Are my lips aflame with the gospel? Who alone can enable me to speak brightly and boldly for Jesus? Am I asking Him to do it?
3. Do I have a passion for Christ's worship and its spread around the globe?
