**QUESTIONS FOR FAMILY WORSHIP**

1. What does the word "devoted" mean? What is the church devoting herself to here?
2. Why did Christ give apostles to the church? Do we still have them today? Should we still be devoted to "the apostle's teaching"?
3. What does it actually look like to be devoted to Christ's word as it is preached, taught, and read?
4. Why can't we just sit at home every week and watch a sermon online? Why is the fellowship of the body not optional for the Christian?
5. What are some practical ways our church could grow in prayer together so that we would look more like the church in Jerusalem?
6. What happens to the church when she is filled with the Spirit and devoted to Christ?

**QUESTIONS FOR PRIVATE REFLECTION**

1. Do I sit under the preaching and teaching of the word with an "aggressive attentiveness"?
2. Do I sense my need of the fellowship of Christ's body day by day (cf. Heb. 3:12-13)? What is one way I could encourage/exhort a fellow member of Cornerstone this week?
3. Am I slow to seek my church's help in times of need? Or am I slow to help others in the church who are in need?
4. How could I be actively seeking to grow in the pursuit of Christ through prayer? What steps could my church take in this regard?
