QUESTIONS FOR FAMILY WORSHIP

1. What does Paul mean when he calls us to do good? Who defines what is good and where do we find that definition?
2. Are good works something we can carry out in our own strength? How do they relate to Christ, the Spirit, and true faith?
3. What does it mean to sow and reap? When does Paul tell us we will reap a reward if we give ourselves to loving service now? How does this encourage us?
4. Who are we called to good toward? If someone is unkind to us, does that mean we don't have to serve them?
5. How can discussions about spiritual gifts sometimes detract us from faithful service in the church?
6. How do you think we are doing as a family in lovingly serving at Cornerstone? How could we grow?

QUESTIONS FOR PRIVATE REFLECTION

1. Am I weary of doing good in my church? If so, what ought I to do with my weariness?
2. Who is the hardest person for me to love at Cornerstone? Am I seeking their physical and eternal welfare out of a heart of genuine affection for them? Am I looking to Christ to help me overcome my lack of love?
3. Have I narrowly defined my spiritual gifts so as to exempt myself from doing good when the opportunity arises?
