

## HEALED TO HERALD

*Acts 9:1-19a // September 5, 2021 AM*

I. The risen Christ is the sovereign Judge of His enemies (vv. 3-9).

II. The risen Christ is the sovereign Savior of His enemies (vv. 10-19).

### QUESTIONS FOR FAMILY WORSHIP

1. Who is Saul? Why is he going to Damascus?
2. Who appears to Saul on the road to Damascus? What similarities does this appearance have to the burning bush in Exodus 3?
3. Why did Jesus say Saul was persecuting him when Jesus was in heavenly glory? How should this comfort us when we suffer for Christ?
4. What was the curse of physical blindness a sign of?
5. Who does Jesus send to heal Saul? What is the reason given for his healing?
6. Is Saul saved here, or is he merely sent? Why must we be saved before we can be faithful witnesses of Christ?

### QUESTIONS FOR PRIVATE REFLECTION

1. How is the sovereignty of Christ highlighted in this account? Why should that be a great comfort in the midst of a society that is increasingly hostile to the gospel?
2. Have my spiritual eyes been healed by Christ? And has that healing led to heralding?
3. Is there anyone in my life that I think is beyond the possibility of salvation? If so, how does this account challenge my pessimism?
