**QUESTIONS FOR FAMILY WORSHIP**

1. Why does the sixth petition imply the reality of spiritual warfare? What is the nature of the battle we are in daily?
2. Pastor Nick defined temptation as "the satanic enticement to sin." Can you give an example of enticement from everyday life? What is Satan's role in the temptations we face?
3. How can God lead us into temptation without tempting us Himself? Why does God allow us to be tempted by the devil?
4. Is this prayer only to be prayed to be kept from temptation, or also to be prayed to be kept in temptation?
5. What is the role of God's word as we pray this prayer and fight against temptation to sin?

**QUESTIONS FOR PRIVATE REFLECTION**

1. Do I live with a peacetime or a wartime mentality? What does my prayer life say about this?
2. As I think of my particular sin struggle(s), are there ways I am willfully running toward temptation? If so, what could I do to change this?
3. As I think of my particular sin struggle(s), what are some passages of Scripture I could memorize to make war on my sin as I cry out to God to keep me from evil?
