

**GOD'S DEATH-DEFEATING DYNASTY**  
*Acts 13:13-52 // February 13, 2022 AM*

**I. The resurrected Jesus enjoys eternal dominion (vv. 16-37).**

- A. Jesus is the incarnate son of David (vv. 17-25).
- B. Jesus is the resurrected son of God (vv. 26-37).

**II. The resurrected Jesus extends eternal life (vv. 38-52).**

- A. Jesus' offer is unmerited (vv. 38-43).
- B. Jesus' offer is universal (vv. 44-52).

**QUESTIONS FOR FAMILY WORSHIP**

1. Where do Paul and Barnabas go after leaving the island of Cyprus?
2. Why do you think they begin their ministry in every new place by going to the synagogue?
3. What promise did God make to David (see 2 Samuel 7) that Paul says has been fulfilled in Christ? How was this promise fulfilled in the resurrection?
4. Why can't the law of God save us?
5. What does it mean to be justified, and how do unrighteous people like us become justified in the sight of God?
6. What does the Jewish rejection of the gospel lead to? What does this teach us about the nature of Christ's kingdom and salvation?

**QUESTIONS FOR PRIVATE REFLECTION**

1. Meditate on Romans 1:16-17. How does this text relate to Paul's sermon in Acts 13?
2. Am I trusting in my own religiosity or morality to earn right standing before God? Or is my only hope in the crucified and resurrected Christ?
3. Is my life marked by Spirit-filled joy because I am increasingly coming to see the grace of God as a citizen of God's death-defeating dynasty?
