QUESTIONS FOR FAMILY WORSHIP

1. Though Acts is history, how does Luke teach us theology through his recounting of history?
2. What are some of the characteristics of the appointment to eternal life spoken of in our text?
3. Why is it not unfair for God to elect some and not all? Is election a matter of justice or grace? How does that make a difference?
4. If God has already decided who He will save, why do we need to share the gospel with people?
5. If God is sovereign, how can He hold us responsible for whether we believe the gospel or not?
6. How can we know if we are elect? Explain the illustration of the door with gospel invitation on one side and gospel assurance on the other.

QUESTIONS FOR PRIVATE REFLECTION

1. How is unconditional, individual election the logical conclusion of salvation by grace?
2. Do I use God's sovereignty to excuse my responsibility, or do I use my responsibility to delimit God's sovereignty?
3. Does my heart exult in Christ by faith, especially as He is preached in public worship?
