QUESTIONS FOR FAMILY WORSHIP

- 1. What did the religious leaders criticize Christ's disciples for not doing? Did God command this in the law?
- 2. How did Jesus turn their criticism on its head, showing them that they are actually the ones at fault?
- 3. What is tradition? Is Jesus completely against all tradition? Or is He combatting a certain kind of tradition?
- 4. What are some ways we can make void God's word by our traditions?
- 5. How does Jesus evidence remarkable humility in the strong words He speaks to the religious leaders? Does humility make us pushovers before men or courageous for God?
- 6. Why is it wrong to think that the food we eat morally defiles us? From where does all defilement come?
- 7. Who alone can change our hearts so that from the inside out we begin to love God and people? How is this foundational to true discipleship?

QUESTIONS FOR PRIVATE REFLECTION

- 1. What is the relationship between God's word and human tradition?
- 2. What are some traditions I adhere to and love? In what specific ways might I be tempted to make void God's word for the sake of those traditions?
- 3. Have I submitted to the Surgeon of surgeons and gotten a new heart by His grace? Why must this happen before even one step can be taken on the path of sincere discipleship?
