# FROM GOD, THROUGH GOD, TO GOD

*Exodus 3:16-4:17*

I. The *covenant* God *enlists* His exodus deliverer (3:16-22).

II. The *creator* God *equips* His exodus deliverer (4:1-17).

## QUESTIONS FOR FAMILY WORSHIP

1. What is the difference between a spirit of self-sufficiency and a spirit of self-inadequacy? How are they related, and what do we need to deliver us from both?
2. Where did God commission Moses to go, and what did He commission him to do?
3. What does it mean to plunder? Why is it so surprising to hear that Israel will plunder the Egyptians? How will this fulfill God's promises?
4. How does God respond to Moses's objection that the elders of Israel will not listen? What do these signs teach us? Should we expect such signs today?
5. How does God respond to Moses's object that he is not a gifted speaker?
6. Is God really the one that makes people deaf and blind? Why is God sovereignty a comfort in our limitations and disabilities?
7. What mission has Christ given the church in the new covenant? How can we struggle with the same fears and doubts that Moses did as we seek to carry it out? Why shouldn't we?

## QUESTIONS FOR PRIVATE REFLECTION

1. Can I explain how a Godward self-perception delivers from being both confident in my own ability and crippled by my own inability?
2. Do God's rhetorical questions in v. 11 make me uncomfortable? If so, why?
3. Though Moses's calling is unique, what lessons can be derived from His call for myself and the church today?
