I. Yahweh's satisfying shelter is my *central* pursuit (vv. 1-6).

II. Yahweh's satisfying shelter is my *certain* pursuit (vv. 7-14).

QUESTIONS FOR FAMILY WORSHIP

1. What is anxiety? What are some different causes of it? How is reckoning with God in His glory and His grace the greatest remedy to an anxious heart?
2. What is the first and last word in the psalm? How does this help us to understand the whole of it?
3. Who is David talking to in vv. 1-6? What does this teach us about how we should respond to scary circumstances or uncertainties?
4. What does it mean to be "a master of one"? What is the "one thing" David is after? How does it apply to Jesus and to us in Him?
5. Where in the Bible did God tell David to seek Him? How did David respond, and why was he confident that God would answer?
6. How did Jesus wait upon the Lord in His tribulations? What does it look like for us to wait patiently in ours?
7. Why should Christians be the most confident people in the world?

QUESTIONS FOR PRIVATE REFLECTION

1. Do I struggle with fear and anxiety? What is the root cause? How might Psalm 27 help me in combatting it?
2. Is the hope of the glory of God the central pursuit of my life that orients every other pursuit?
3. Is my soul marked not by carnal confidence, but Christian confidence?
