QUESTIONS FOR FAMILY WORSHIP

- 1. Why do we tend to grow spiritually careless and self-sufficient when life is going well? How does this help us understand God's wisdom in ordaining trials in our lives?
- 2. Israel is still in Rephidim (v. 8). What test had they faced here already, and what test do they face now?
- 3. Who are the Amalekites? How does God's initial gospel promise in Genesis 3:15 help us to understand what is happening here?
- 4. In what ways does this battle reveal Israel's weakness and the weakness of their mediator? How does it apply to us?
- 5. Why is Moses raising his hands, and how does it relate to the name he gives the altar?
- 6. If God's throne was against us in our sin, how can it be for us now? How does this help us to understand the role of Moses in this story?
- 7. Why does God will throughout all of redemptive history to show His power in human weakness?

QUESTIONS FOR PRIVATE REFLECTION

- 1. Why is a trial-less wilderness more spiritually dangerous for me than a trying one? How has God used trials in recent months to humble me?
- 2. Pastor Nick keeps referring to the history of Israel as "a living catechism." Do I agree with him? Why, or why not?
- 3. Read 2 Corinthians 12:9-10. How does this shed light on the application of the account in Exodus 17:8-16? Am I learning to boast in my weaknesses, or do I still tend to boast in my strengths?
