## QUESTIONS FOR FAMILY WORSHIP

1. Where have we seen the word "blessed" before in the psalms? What does it mean to be blessed?
2. How does our sin keep us from blessedness? What does David say God must do with our sin if we would be blessed?
3. Why was the conviction David experienced in vv. 3-4 good news? Why is it a mercy when God convicts us of our sin?
4. Instead of trying to hide our sin from God, what does this psalm call us to do?
5. How can God forgive our sin? Can He turn a blind eye to it and pretend it didn't happen?
6. Read Romans 4:5-8. Was there a different way of salvation under the old covenant than under the new?
7. Why should Christians be the most joyful people on the planet, even when they are going through great difficulties?

## QUESTIONS FOR PRIVATE REFLECTION

1. How do I respond to God's gracious conviction? Am I hiding my sin behind a façade of righteousness and religiosity?
2. Do I know the blessedness David sings of here, and is the ongoing appropriation of this gospel grace fueling my joy?
3. Meditate on the second half of v. 10. How does this encourage and reorient me?

## GOD BECKONS US INTO HIS PRESENCE

### **\*God's Call to Worship** | Hebrews 12:22-29

Pastor: You have come to Mount Zion and to the city of the living God, the heavenly Jerusalem, and to innumerable angels in festal gathering, and to the assembly of the firstborn who are enrolled in heaven, and to God, the judge of all, and to the spirits of the righteous made perfect, and to Jesus, the mediator of a new covenant, and to the sprinkled blood that speaks a better word than the blood of Abel.

**People: See that you do not refuse him who is speaking. For if they did not escape when they refused him who warned them on earth, much less will we escape if we reject him who warns from heaven.**

Pastor: At that time his voice shook the earth, but now he has promised, "Yet once more I will shake not only the earth but also the heavens." This phrase, "Yet once more," indicates the removal of things that are shaken—that is, things that have been made—in order that the things that cannot be shaken may remain.

**People: Therefore let us be grateful for receiving a kingdom that cannot be shaken, and thus let us offer to God acceptable worship, with reverence and awe, for our God is a consuming fire.**
