THE FOLLY OF FAVORITISM

Saving faith is incompatible with worldly favoritism.

- I. Favoritism contradicts God's gospel (vv. 1-7).
- II. Favoritism contradicts God's law (vv. 8-13).

QUESTIONS FOR FAMILY WORSHIP

- 1. What is partiality? How were the Christians James addresses falling prey to this sin?
- 2. Why does James refer to Jesus as "the Lord of glory"? What does that have to do with showing partiality to the worldly rich?
- 3. How does worldly favoritism contradict the gospel?
- 4. How does it contradict the law?
- 5. What was the point Pastor Nick made in his illustration about the buffet? Why can't we pick and choose which commandments we live by?
- 6. How can being under God's law be spoken of as liberty (v. 12)?
- 7. Is James teaching that we will be saved by our works of mercy and love on judgment day? How are we to understand vv. 12-13?

QUESTIONS FOR PRIVATE RELFECTION

- 1. In what way am I particularly tempted to show worldly favoritism? What about my church?
- 2. How is James' prohibition of partiality not a call to endorse sin or to celebrate sinful lifestyles?
- 3. Does my life evidence a love that harmonizes with both the law and the gospel? Is there any area of my life where I am justifying lovelessness, picking and choosing which commands I keep?
