COVENANT RATIFIED AND RENEWED: PART ONE

Fxodus 24:1-8

God's one-time ratification of His covenant gives the basic framework for its ongoing renewal.

I. Respect the covenant boundaries (vv. 1-2).

II. Receive the covenant book (vv. 3-4a, 7).

III. Rely on the covenant blood (vv. 4b-6, 8).

GOD BECKONS US INTO HIS PRESENCE

*God's Call to Worship | Psalm 15; Hebrews 12

Pastor: O LORD, who shall sojourn in your tent? Who shall dwell on your holy hill?

People: He who walks blamelessly and does what is right and speaks truth in his heart; who does not slander with his tongue and does no evil to his neighbor, nor takes up a reproach against his friend; in whose eyes a vile person is despised, but who honors those who fear the LORD; who swears to his own hurt and does not change; who does not put out his money at interest and does not take a bribe against the innocent. He who does these things shall never be moved.

Pastor: We have not come to what may be touched, a blazing fire and darkness and gloom and a tempest and the sound of a trumpet and a voice whose words made the hearers beg that no further messages be spoken to them.
