God's one-time ratification of His covenant gives the basic framework for its ongoing renewal.

II. *Relish the covenant blessing* (vv. 12-18).

QUESTIONS FOR FAMILY WORSHIP

1. What was the liturgy (order of worship) on mount Eden? What is similar and what is different about the liturgy of covenant ratification and renewal given at mount Sinai?
2. What did the leaders see when they got mid-point up the mountain? Why is there a focus on the floor?
3. God called Adam and Israel to feast in His presence. What about us? Does God share a covenant meal with us today?
4. Who alone was able to ascend to the peak of Sinai? Why?
5. What is the significance of six days and the seventh day in v. 16? What day did this covenant ceremony begin, and what day did God speak to Moses inviting him to enter into the cloud of His glory? Why does it matter?
6. What does forty symbolize? And what is the significance of Moses remaining on the mount for forty days?
7. How does all of this point to Jesus and apply to us under the new covenant?

QUESTIONS FOR PRIVATE REFLECTION

1. Do I agree that new covenant worship is to the end of renewing covenant with God? Why, or why not?
2. Why is food an important component to fellowship? Do I prize the Lord's Supper and view it as vital to deepening my communion with Christ?
3. In this period of testing, am I eyeing the exalted mediator and regularly renewing covenant with Him so as to make it to my promised rest?
