Despite earthly woes, exuberantly worship and expectantly wait for your God.

I. Because of God's sovereign *command* (vv. 4-9).

II. Because of God's sovereign *counsel* (vv. 10-12).

III. Because of God's sovereign *care* (vv. 13-19).

QUESTIONS FOR FAMILY WORSHIP

1. The opening verses of Psalm 33 might lead us to think David is going through a good time. Is that the case?
2. What does it mean for something to fit? What befits the people of God?
3. How did God create all things? Why is God's creative word so encouraging in the midst of the trials we face in this life?
4. Can you give an example from your life or the Bible when God thwarted the evil plan of the devil by turning it to fulfill His good plan?
5. What does it mean to be God's heritage? Why is this alone reason to make our hearts sing?
6. While God's eyes are upon every person, how are they particularly on His people?
7. Can you summarize the three reasons David gives for why believers should have joy and hope in their sufferings?

QUESTIONS FOR PRIVATE REFLECTION

1. Why is God's fatherly sovereignty in Jesus Christ a rock and refuge for God's people? Is it a rock and refuge for me?
2. Am I living before the face of God? How is the teaching about God's eye in Psalm 33 both sobering and comforting?
3. Do I regularly meditate on God's works of creation, providence, and redemption? And are they reorienting how I view my present trials?
