I. Come to His *feast* (vv. 23-30).

II. Come *before* His *face* (vv. 31-40).

QUESTIONS FOR FAMILY WORSHIP

1. Can anything in this world truly fulfill the longings of our hearts? If not, what does this teach us?
2. Can you describe the table in the Holy Place? What materials was it made of, how was it designed, and how was it carried? What do we learn about it from this?
3. What was to be placed on plates on top of the table, and how often was it to be replaced?
4. What would happen to the old bread when it was replaced with new on the sabbath day? What is this a picture of, and how does it relate to new covenant worship?
5. Can you describe the lampstand in the Holy Place? What was it designed to look like, and why?
6. How many lamps did the lampstand have, and what were they to shine on?
7. What message does God communicate through these two pieces of furniture, and how do they lead us to Jesus?

QUESTIONS FOR PRIVATE REFLECTION

1. Can I give some examples from my own experience of how even the best things in this life haven't had the ability to satisfy my soul? What does this teach me?
2. How would I explain the relevance and significance of the golden table and lampstand to an unbeliever in my life?
3. Am I unlearning the lies of this present evil age and learning to find my joy in fellowship with God through Christ?
