### QUESTIONS FOR FAMILY WORSHIP

1. What does book three of the psalter focus on? How does it help us to understand and apply Psalm 78?
2. Read Matthew 13:35. How does Jesus fulfill Psalm 78? How does this inform the way we should read Asaph's words?
3. How many generations are spoken of in these opening verses? Can you show them from the text?
4. According to this psalm, who has the primary responsibility to teach God's word to the coming generation? Why?
5. What should be the goal of parents in teaching the Bible to their kids? How is that goal set forth both positively and negatively in our text?
6. Why isn't it enough for us to know the Bible in our heads?
7. Why is family worship a great blessing that we should be grateful for?

### QUESTIONS FOR PRIVATE REFLECTION

1. What role does the home play in God's plan for the future generations?
2. How does Psalm 78 as a whole make clear that no generation is beyond hope?
3. What does it look like for me to pray and labor unto the end of Gen Grace?
