II. The eternal God is your never-ending strength (v. 27b).

QUESTIONS FOR FAMILY WORSHIP

1. While different cultures view time different, what is true about every culture in relation to time?
2. What does it mean for God to be eternal? Does God exist in time without beginning and end, or does He exist outside of time without beginning and end?
3. Pastor Nick said that God doesn't have a birthday. What did he mean? How is this a comfort to us?
4. Is it right to say that if God doesn't have a birthday, then God also doesn't have a funeral? Why, or why not?
5. Have you ever been comforted by the loving embrace of another person? How is that different from the loving embrace of God here?
6. What is all of time moving toward according to God's eternal purpose? How was Israel's conquest of Canaan a faint picture of that?

QUESTIONS FOR PRIVATE REFLECTION

1. What are the three key components of God's eternity? Can I comprehend any of these components?
2. How does God's eternality relate to His infinitude (last week's sermon)?
3. Is God my never-beginning refuge and my never-ending strength through Christ? Or am I putting my trust in created things that are time-bound and fleeting?
