QUESTIONS FOR FAMILY WORSHIP

1. What is the difference between knowledge and wisdom? The Japanese proverb says, "Knowledge without wisdom is a load of books on the back of an ass." What is the point?
2. What has happened to Daniel that is leading him to worship God here? What attribute does Daniel focus on in his praise?
3. What is God's wisdom? Does He seek out counsel from others to get it?
4. How is God's wisdom displayed in creation and providence/history? Can you give some specific examples?
5. If God gives saving wisdom through His revelation, where does He reveal Himself today?
6. How is worship the path to growing to reflect God in wisdom?

QUESTIONS FOR PRIVATE REFLECTION

1. Do I tend to mistake knowledge for wisdom? How does knowledge become wisdom?
2. Even when I don't understand God's ways with me, do I still trust and praise Him for His wisdom?
3. Do I ponder God's word and proclaim it to others so that I am growing in God-fearing wisdom and spreading it to others?
