QUESTIONS FOR FAMILY WORSHIP

- 1. What is the tent and mountain that David is referring to in v. 1? Why would he and anyone else want to dwell there?
- 2. Read Psalm 5:4 and Psalm 14:2-3. What does this tell us about the answer to David's question in Psalm 15:1?
- 3. Where was the first holy mountain and who was the first priest? How did his disobedience and banishment from God's mount effect the rest of the human race?
- 4. What are the qualifications David speaks of for being God's priest? What is one word that would summarize them all?
- 5. Who is the only one that truly meets all the qualifications in Himself?
- 6. How does Jesus qualify us to serve God on His mount?
- 7. Where is God's holy mountain now, and how do we get there?

QUESTIONS FOR PRIVATE REFLECTION

- 1. How does a biblical theology of holy mountains serve as a helpful summary of covenant history? Could you explain the connections between Mt. Eden, Mt. Sinai, and Mt. Zion?
- 2. How does Psalm 15 simultaneously bring conviction as law and comfort as gospel?
- 3. Do I receive the word and sacrament and respond in prayer and praise all through faith in Christ and His priestly mediation? Is Jesus central in my private, family, and public worship?
